

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

THE BIG LONDON NIGHT WALK

FRIDAY 1ST OCTOBER 2010

By registering yourself / your team to take part in The Big Issue Foundation The Big London Night Walk 2010 (the 'Event') you are agreeing to the following conditions of entry.

- 01.** Adult Hikers must be at least 17 years of age (by the 1st October 2010) to participate, whilst Child Hikers (16 years or under) must be accompanied by a participating adult.
- 02.** You must pay a non-refundable registration fee of £30 per adult, £100 per challenge team (4-6 members) and £15 per child participant, when submitting this form. No place is secured until this fee is received and on the occasion that the Event is full we will refund your registration fee.
- 03.** All adults should commit to raising a minimum sponsorship requirement of £250 per person and children try to raise a target of £100. Teams should endeavour to raise £1000 between their members.
- 04.** You must send any sponsorship money, which you have raised to The Big Issue Foundation as soon as possible. Fundraising deadline for all monies by 1st November 2010.
- 05.** If for any reason you or a team member choose not to take up your place / are not permitted to take part in the event / the event is cancelled, all sponsorship forms and money collected must be forwarded to The Big Issue Foundation and will not be refunded.
- 06.** The Big Issue Foundation has no responsibility to ensure that you are fit for the Event; you must all ensure that you have the appropriate level of fitness to take part. You must all confirm that, to the best of your knowledge, you are currently in a good state of health and that you will not take part in the Event unless you are in a good state of health at the time. If you have any health concerns at any time about taking part, you should speak to your doctor.
- 07.** Any hiker over 65 years of age at the time of the Event must provide The Big Issue Foundation with a letter from their GP stating that they are fit to take part in the Event.
- 08.** You / your team are all taking part in the Event at your own risk. Neither The Big Issue Foundation nor the organisers will have any responsibility for any risk, loss or costs which you incur in connection with the Event and you will indemnify The Big Issue Foundation, the organisers and any persons acting on their behalf for any risk, damages, loss or costs arising as a result of your participation in the Event.
- 09.** Neither The Big Issue Foundation nor the organisers will carry insurance in relation to your participation in the Event so it is your responsibility to obtain any necessary insurance in connection with the Event.
- 10.** You / your team will all comply with The Big Issue Foundations guidelines when raising fundraising for the Event. Details of these guidelines are available on request.
- 11.** You must all provide The Big Issue Foundation, the organisers and any persons acting on their behalf with information, which they may request in connection with the Event. Any photographs taken at the event and given to The Big Issue Foundation will be usable by The Big Issue Foundation in future publicity materials.
- 12.** Prior to and during the event you / your team will be responsible for your own safety, you will take reasonable care to ensure the safety of other participants and you will comply promptly with all instructions and guidelines given by The Big Issue Foundation, the organisers and any persons acting on their behalf.
- 13.** You / your team accept that the interests and reputation of The Big Issue Foundation are of paramount importance. The Big Issue Foundation may at any time and at its sole discretion, cancel the Event, change the published venues, withdraw your place on the Event or exclude you from the Event.
- 14.** You / your team give permission to use your name, photograph, voice, or likeness in any broadcast, telecast, advertising promotion, or other account of this event, or marketing, or promotion for future or similar events and waive any rights of privacy that you may have in that regard.
